

Orange Acres Well #2

May 8, 2007



GENERAL INFORMATION:

This community is at north east of Cantón Metalío, where Orange Acres sponsored its first well. It's about a mile away. Most of these people here work fishing, farming and ranching. Work opportunities are very scarce here, so many people spend a lot of their time looking for work. Not all of them have a well at their houses due to the fact that the water is very deep. One must dig more than 60 feet to get to water, so they go to their neighbors to ask for scarce water, which sometimes dries up, and the water from these hand-dug wells is not clean. They had been hoping for a water project that had been promised to them years ago, but never came to anything, praying for something else to come along.

TESTIMONIAL:

Luis Angel Menendez: I am the president of de ADESCO. I am 52 years old. The prayers of the board members of this community were answered! We are so grateful with you, because now we have a well that will give us clean water after each game. We do not have to carry more water bags from place to place. Now we have our own well. We couldn't have water before. And it is not only the soccer teams that benefit from the well at the soccer field but all the community. Families from all around here will come daily to get water from the well.



Jorge Cabrera: I am a farmer. We are very pleased because the well is at the right place. It will benefit the whole community. Most of the people do not have a well in their houses, because the soil is very hard and wells are very difficult to dig by ourselves. There was a government project that was coming three years ago but never came. All the people that live here around the well will go to it to get water because it is easy to obtain and the most import is that this water is good quality. Many times what wells do exist at the houses dry up in the summer time because they are not very deep and for that reason there was a season that we did not have water at all and we had to buy it from a water truck every week.



EVANGELISM:

At this community we played the movie "Jesus". It had an impact for the church of the community, 3 adults accepted Christ that day. We spoke to the pastor to do a follow up on these people. During the film we spoke of Jesus to the people who came to see the drilling of the well. We gave away tracts and we gave a Bible to each family that showed up.
